- 3. Approval of Minutes of June 14, 2023. Motion to Approve "as clarified" (Popic, Maddox) APPROVED
- 4. Resident Requests Requests and related documents sent to ARB members prior to this meeting.
  - 1. **4 Blue Spruce, Jeff & Laura Karcher**—ARB Chair sent letter on June 19 detailing information needed to complete the request for an AC unit proposed to the side of the residence. A copy is attached. Resident subsequently called and said due to busy schedule had not taken any action on his request. **No further ARB action required at this time.**
  - 2. 11 Gray Birch, Natalie & Steven Wheeler—The Wheelers request a Radon Mitigation system installation due to high levels of radon detected. They also want to eliminate water entry into the basement: The plan is to have Zander Solutions remove the lower board on the foundation wall, apply waterproofing to the foundation slab up covering a portion of the exterior wall, then reinstall the board after access is no longer needed. ARB Form 2, a proposal from Zander for the requested work, and photos have been submitted.
    - MOTION 1 (Popic, Hughes) to Approve Radon Mitigation Proposal with provision that current Zander Certificate of Insurance be provided. APPROVED
    - MOTION 2 (Popic, Maddox) to Approve proposal for Water Problem, with provision that all materials must meet BoS specifications regarding exterior trim and colors, landscaping/reseeding must be coordinated with TT Landscaping Superintendent, current Zander Certificate of Insurance be provided. APPROVED

## 5. Chair's report

Reminder that on July 20 the TT Board of Directors will vote on including the revised Book of Standards (BoS) in Policy IV-400. This does not change the BoS which was approved in its entirety by the Board 4/25/2023.

## 6. Ongoing Business

- Spring Walkaround Summary—The Annual Walkaround has been completed; a few missing reports are now submitted. Results will be summarized for the August Good Life, and documentation including photos will be submitted to the Tamarack Office.
   In general, approximately 20% of all unit exteriors are in good condition, 37 satellite dishes were noted, 32 reports of window issues (clouded panes, torn screens, bent frames) as well as a lot of wood trim rot.
- 2. A list of proposed ARB decision criteria for exceptions to BoS standards continues to be refined.

#### 7. Old Business

- 1. Reports on Completed of Approved Projects; updates on in-progress/ not started projects:
  - **71 Oak Creek** The Whites are awaiting architect's drawings of proposed deck revision. A power line was detected that interferes with placement of a post. Architect suggested the extension could be cantilevered to render a post unnecessary. Options are under review.
  - **22 Pin Oak** A flagstone path to a water spigot on back wall of the unit has been completed, all forms were submitted to TT Association Manager. Path does not exceed 15 sq. feet.
