Board and Committee Business

Board Meeting Highlights - December 17, 2024

As **Community Correspondence**, three residents expressed concern about the policy to restrict membership to one committee.

A new maintenance technician will be starting in January 2025.

The **Reserve Study** of our property has been completed. The study provides an inventory of our property, life estimates, a funding plan, and valuation estimates. A presentation will be scheduled to present the results to the community.

Following a payment of \$615,692.15 to Badger Pools for the work that was completed in 2024, the **investment accounts** balance on November 30, 2024, were:

Edward Jones: \$11,900US Bank: \$649,400

The **Human Resources** recommendation to provide staff with a paid floating holiday was approved by the board. The staff will have 9 holidays starting in 2025. Also approved were the 2025 salaries and 2024 end-of-year bonus.

The changes to Policy V-501, Paragraph 2, Sections A & B regarding **deck replacement** were adopted. When replacing decks, owners will be able to upgrade their deck materials with a 50% cost-sharing process.

Along with a survey, a ZOOM meeting and an onsite walk of the **Sauk Creek Greenway** was held in December by the City Engineering Department. Their next meeting will be in January.

The **50**th **Anniversary Committee** is putting together a time capsule.

Finally, the Board adopted the **Code of Ethics**.

ARB News: At our January 8th meeting, the ARB will elect new officers for 2025. Eve Siegel has resigned after five very helpful years and Pat Maddox is 'terming out' after six years on the ARB which leaves two vacancies. We hope to add one new recruit at the January meeting, but we still need one more to fill our board with seven members. We do important work monitoring the external integrity of the design and appearance of our condos. Serving on the ARB is a great way to meet other residents and learn where each and every trail is in Tamarack! Contact any ARB member or the office regarding your interest.

Reminder about holiday lights - Here is an excerpt from the Book of Standards on Decorative Lighting: Homeowners may install miniature, non-twinkling, white lights during the dark winter months between the end of Daylight Savings Time in the fall and the beginning of Daylight Savings Time in the spring, at which time the lights must be removed, not simply turned off. Owners are responsible for removing the lights from trees or shrubs to facilitate pruning.

Strings of colored or white lights are allowed from December 1 through January 15. They may be installed earlier to avoid frigid weather but not turned on until December 1. All outside seasonal decorative lighting must be confined to the Owner's Living Unit and within the Lot. Owners may not use nails or screws to hang lights or garlands because of potential damage to siding, trim or fences.

My fond farewell to the ARB: The January meeting will be my last as chair of the ARB. The year 2024 was a busy and rewarding year for the ARB and I am proud of the work we do and our track record of doing timely minutes, agendas, processing resident requests, and performing the annual walkaround of all Tamarack residences. Each member of the ARB over the past year has actively participated in meetings and shared in performing the many responsibilities the ARB has outside of meetings. The 2024 BOD liaison to the ARB Dave Larson was also a helpful addition to our team last year.
